Protect Yourself and Others *Safely Dispose of Used Needles and Expired Medications*

Did You Know?

It's *illegal* to throw expired medications and used medical needles (sharps) in your trash and recycle bins or down the drain. Unsafe disposal can result in contamination, pollution and endangers the lives of sanitation and health workers.

Avoid harmful situations.

DON'T...

- **THROW** sharps in trash or recycle containers
- **FLUSH** expired or unwanted medications down the toilet
- **STORE** sharps in plastic milk jugs, bleach or soda bottles
