Dear Customer:

On June 18, 2013, after a noticed public hearing, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 13-1642 to establish sewer charges to pay for the operation and maintenance of the City's sewer system, including capital replacement costs. Ordinance No. 13-1642 provides that beginning July 1, 2014, the sewer service charge may be increased annually by an amount equal to the annual increase in the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index for the Los Angeles Area (the "ENRLA"), as of February of each year. The annual increase in the ENRLA as of February 2016 is 1.30%. This notice is to inform you that on July 1, 2016, the City will increase the sewer charges as provided in the following schedule approved by City Council on May 3, 2016 and authorized by Ordinance No. 13-1642:
