CONSEQUENCES OF FAILURE TO PAY THE FULL PENALTY AMOUNT - The failure of any person to pay the full penalty assessed by the Administrative Citation within the time specified on the citation or on the invoice from the Revenue Collector may result in the notification to the State of California Franchise Tax Board, or the City of Norwalk pursuing any legal remedies to collect all Civil penalties and any associated charges. Each and every day any violation of the City of Norwalk Municipal Code, any condition(s) of any land use entitlement or state laws exists, constitutes a separate and distinct offense and shall be subject to a citation. Additional Administrative Citations may be issued to you for the same violation(s) if the violation(s) are not corrected. Penalties incurred are \$100 for each violation – 1st Citation; \$200 for each violation – 2nd Citation; \$500 for each violation – 3nd and subsequent citations. Any responsible party may also be criminally prosecuted for failure to pay the amount due. Any fine not paid in full within the allotted timeframe is subject to a late payment fee.
