Dear Customer:

On June 18, 2013, after a noticed public hearing, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 13-1642 to establish sewer charges to pay for the operation and maintenance of the City's sewer system, including capital replacement costs. Ordinance No. 13-1642 provides that beginning July 1, 2014, the sewer service charge may be increased annually by an amount equal to the annual increase in the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index for the Los Angeles Area (the "ENRLA"), as of February of each year. On November 21, 2017, City Council voted to continue to levy and collect the sewer service charge with no increase each fiscal year until the City updates its 2015 Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP) and a new sewer service fee study. The sewer charges will remain as approved by City Council on June 4, 2019:

The sewer charges listed above will be collected from each property owner through the Los Angeles County Assessor property tax bill.
