City of Norwalk Departments

Administration (562) 929-5944

Responsible for legislative tracking, waste management and recycling programs, providing the community with citywide information through the production of the “Norwalk Now”, press releases, social media, and coordination of special events. Heads the Successor Agency to the Norwalk Redevelopment Agency and coordinates the grant activities of the City.

City Clerk (562) 929-5720

Conducts City elections, prepares agendas for City Council and other City boards, provides and responds to requests for public record information pursuant to the Public Records Act; certifies and distributes ordinances and resolutions, publishes and posts legal notices, processes claims and lawsuits, and maintains the Norwalk Municipal Code.

Community Development (562) 929-5744

Responsible for all development within the City. The Department includes: Economic Development, Building & Safety, Planning, CDBG/HOME and Housing Authority.

Building & Safety (562) 929-5733

Issues building permits and performs inspections related to construction, remodeling, alteration, repair and demolition activities in Norwalk.

CDBG/Home (562) 929-5951

Provides home improvement grants and loans for low to moderate income residents who have owned and lived in their homes for at least two years.

Economic Development (562) 929-5744

Fosters growth in the City by supporting existing businesses, generating new development opportunities, working to expand education and job opportunities for residents, and attracting prospective developers, businesses, residents, and visitors.

Housing Authority (562) 929-5588

Provides rental assistance to low-income families through the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program.

Planning (562) 929-5744

Oversees all future and current land use planning, zoning regulations, and compliance with California Environmental Quality Act.

Finance (562) 929-5750

Responsible for business licensing, dog licensing, water billing, budgeting, fiscal oversight, accounting, accounts payable and receivable, payroll, fixed assets, revenue collection, financial reporting, debt management, cash handling, investments, and purchasing.

Business Licensing (562) 929-5713

Animal Licensing (562) 929-5711

Water Billing (562) 929-5766

Human Resources (562) 929-5721

Manages the recruitment and selection process for full-time and part-time positions, conducts new employee orientations and administers the employee benefits program and performance evaluation system, provides job-related training, and maintains personnel records.

Public Safety (562) 929-5732

Responds to requests for safety service and information, handles municipal code enforcement, parking enforcement, conduct high-visibility patrols of the City’s parks, facilities, neighborhoods, and the commercial and business areas. Conducts informational outreach to the community on public safety matters and provides emergency preparedness programs.

Code Compliance (562) 929-5730

Works with property owners to address property maintenance issues.

Public Services (562) 929-5511

Responsible for maintaining the City’s public facilities and parks, right of ways, and infrastructure. Preserves the cleanliness and physical integrity of the City to ensure safety of the public, including maintenance of lighting, landscaping, graffiti removal, streets and sidewalks, tree trimming, and water and sewer services.

Engineering (562) 929-5723

Oversees capital improvement and rehabilitation of Norwalk’s infrastructure including streets and all traffic related activities.

Environmental Services (562) 929-5723

Oversees compliance to State-issued storm water permit and manages business pollutant discharge inspections and related storm water activities.

Recreation & Park Services (562) 929-5702

Provides services for participants of all ages, center and park activities, and citywide special events, including special interest classes and workshops, recreation for the physically challenged, excursions, sports and aquatics programs, athletic leagues, day camps, holiday events, and a variety of special activities.

Senior Center (562) 929-5580

Offers recreational, social, supportive services, educational and health-related programs that service the City’s senior citizens.

Social Service Center (562) 929-5544

Offers a wide range of emergency, supportive services and dispute resolution assistance to residents in need in order to help stabilize their situation.

Child Care Development Program (562) 462-1713

Offers assistance to pre-qualified families with paying for all or part of child care expenses.

Transportation (562) 929-5550

Provides fixed bus route and Dial-A-Ride services to Norwalk and surrounding communities.
