## **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

Please be advised that the Norwalk Housing Authority (NHA) is currently in a shortfall, which means we have limited funds available to assist with your move. This impacts you in the following manner:

- 1. Due to the lack of funds, we will **not honor voluntary moves** where the contract rent is higher than the current unit's contract rent.
- 2. We will **only** be able to grant moves to higher rent units for an **approved** reasonable accommodation or owner initiated moves.
- 3. All owner packets for voluntary moves not connected to a reasonable accommodation resulting in a higher contract rent will be **cancelled**.
- 4. If you are requesting to <u>PORT</u> to another agency, the receiving agency must be <u>"absorbing"</u> your move <u>OR</u> you must find a unit that results in the <u>NHA portion being lower than it is at your current unit.</u>

\*\*If the NHA portion is higher, moving into that unit will be denied.

\*\*\*You may have to search for another unit OR cancel your move and remain in Norwalk.

We apologize for the inconvenience this may cause you. We will notify you when more funds become available and the NHA is no longer in a shortfall.
