OWNER'S ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND VERIFICATION OF INFORMATION
INSTRUCTIONS: Read and initial each statement below to signify you understand or verify this information.
2. I understand building permits are not required to be signed by property owners unless they are <i>responsible</i> for the construction and are not hiring a licensed Contractor to assume this responsibility.
3. I understand as an "Owner-Builder" I am the responsible party of record on the permit. I understand that I may protect myself from potential financial risk by hiring a licensed Contractor and having the permit filed in his or her name instead of my own.
4. I understand Contractors are required by law to be licensed and bonded in California and to list their license numbers on permits and contracts.
5. I understand if I employ or otherwise engage any person(s), other than California licensed Contractor(s), and the total value of my construction is at least five hundred dollars (\$500), including labor and materials, I may be considered an "employer" under State and Federal law.
6. I understand if I am considered an "employer" under State and Federal law, I must register with the State and Federal government, withhold payroll workers' compensation disability insurance, and
