Used motor oil should NEVER be dumped on the ground, into storm drains, or into trash cans. Dumping motor oil from a single oil change can pollute one million gallons of water. That's enough water to supply 50 people for one year.

There are 2 easy ways to properly dispose of your used motor oil and filters:
