SC FUELS EXTENSION OF AGREEMENT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF UNLEADED AND DIESEL FUEL - City Council approved a one (1) year extension of the agreement with SC Fuels in the amount of \$436,957.20, for the term of March 1, 2015 through February 28, 2016; and authorized the City Manager to execute the extension, in a form approved by the City Attorney.
