NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND PUBLIC MEETING OF ANALYSIS OF IMPEDIMENTS TO FAIR HOUSING CHOICE FOR THE 2025-2030 CONSOLIDATED PLAN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice (AI) as part of the 2025-2030 Consolidated Plan (ConPlan) process will be made available to the public for examination and commenting. The commenting period will be held for 30 days beginning October 21, 2024, and ending November 21, 2024. **Additionally, notice is hereby given** that a public meeting regarding the report will be held at City Council Chambers, located at 12700 Norwalk Boulevard, on **Thursday, November 14, 2024, at 11:00 AM**. Interested residents and local organizations are encouraged to attend and provide input on the AI. The report will be adopted by City Council on December 3, 2024, during the City Council meeting.

The AI is a critical component of the ConPlan required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for jurisdictions receiving federal grants. The AI identifies barriers to fair housing within Norwalk and outlines actions to address these jurisdictions. The report is used to promote fair housing and equal opportunities in housing and community development programs.

The 5-Year ConPlan is a comprehensive planning report that the City must prepare and submit to receive federal funding, such as Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) funds. This report outlines the City's priorities and goals for housing and community development needs over a five-year period.
