



Coming Soon to Norwalk

Duckett-Wilson Development Company is in the process of adding more businesses to Paddison Square Shopping Center located on the corner of Norwalk Boulevard and Imperial Highway.

Currently being constructed are two new 2,600 square foot buildings, one adjacent to Bank of America on Norwalk Boulevard, and the other adjacent to Chevron on Imperial Highway. Furthermore, there is also construction of a 10,800 square foot building immediately adjacent to the Target Garden Center. At this time plans for the new building that will be constructed call for 6 retail tenant spaces ranging in size from 1,132 to 3,000 square feet.

As for what business tenants are going to occupy the new buildings, that is still being determined at this time.

Along with the development of the new buildings, they are also remodeling and modifying the existing Paddison Square exterior facades of the buildings within the shopping center to give the shopping center a great new look.

Another on-site improvement that will be made to the Paddison Square Shopping Center will be the replacement of the existing parking lot lighting fixtures. There will be a total of 17 new on-site parking lot light fixtures provided throughout the portion of the shopping center.

Some additional architectural features and changes within the Paddison Square Shopping Center will include:

- A 6-foot wide building canopy that projects from the exterior walls of each of the new existing on-site buildings. Not only will this provide an overhead cover for the pedestrian walkways around the shopping center, it will create a strong architectural element that unifies and links all of the buildings from Target to the south.
- Arches and columns throughout the shopping center
- Tower elements throughout the center to provide added depth and dimension

We look forward to the completion of the buildings and the arrival of more businesses.
