#### FORMER NFL STAR MARK SEAY TESTIMONIAL SPEAKER

Former NFL Wide Receiver will be the Prayer Breakfast Testimonial Speaker. He began his athletic career while attending San Bernardino High School. He then spent two years playing baseball with the Texas Rangers Baseball Organization.

In 1987, he decided to return to Long Beach State University and play under the legendary Coach George Allen. On October 30, 1988, he returned home to attend a Halloween party for his sister's three young children. On that day, Mark became the victim of a random drive-by shooting. After the accident, Long Beach State University declared Mark medically ineligible to play football. Mark fought back and worked hard to be reinstated to the team, and in 1990 his hard work paid off. He played for the Long Beach State 49ers until 1992,



when he signed up as a free agent with the San Francisco 49ers. In 1993, he was signed with the San Diego Chargers and became their leading Wide Receiver. To date, Mark has given motivational talks to over 250,000 students in the communities served by Stater Bros. Markets.
